

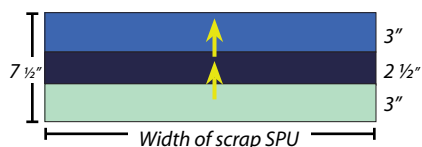
Scrap Salad for Reflections

This pattern is designed to use the left over fabric and strip pieced scraps from the Toadusew pattern "Reflections". If you do not have a copy of this pattern you can still make this quilt by cutting and sewing the pieces listed in each step.



STEP 1 Strip Pieced Units

Using the leftover uncut SPU units 1, 2, 3 and 4, true the ends and repress all seams in the same direction.



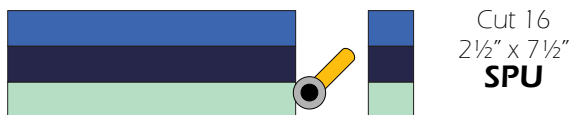
Not Using Reflections Scraps?

Using fabrics from your stash, cut the strips listed below and make some strip pieced units as illustrated in step 1.

- 1 medium color strips 3 1/2" x width of fabric (top strip)
- 1 dark strips 3" x width of fabric (center strip)
- 1 light color strips 3 1/2" x width of fabric (bottom strip)

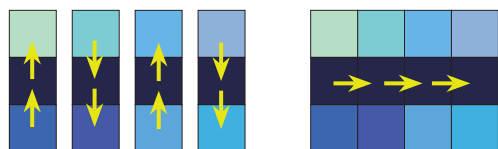
STEP 2

From your strip pieced units, cut a total of sixteen 2 1/2 x 7 1/2 inch smaller strip pieced units (SPU).



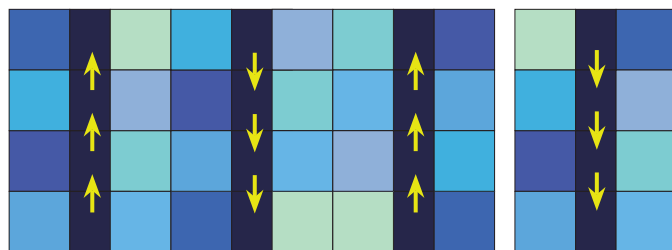
STEP 3 Making the Blocks

Sew together four SPU, of assorted colors, matching up the center colors and making sure the seams alternate in opposite directions as illustrated. Press the new seams in the same direction. Make four blocks.



STEP 4 Making the Center

Sew the four blocks together into rows, positioning the pieces so that the seams alternate direction as illustrated. Press the newly sewn seams to the least amount of bulk. The quilt center is now complete and should measure 8 1/2 x 28 1/2 inches.

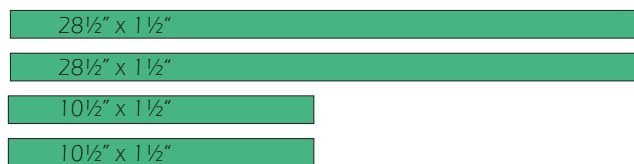


STEP 5 Cutting the Borders

Using your remaining scraps or fabrics from your stash cut the borders, as listed below:

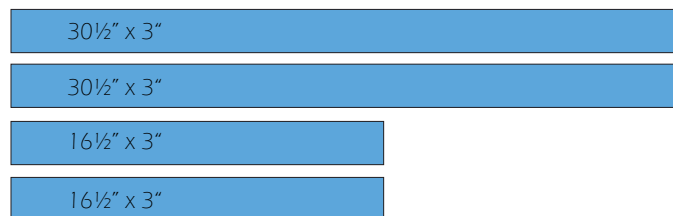
First Border

Cut 2 Long Borders for the sides 28 1/2 x 1 1/2 inches
Cut 2 Short Borders for the ends 10 1/2 x 1 1/2 inches



Second Border

Cut 2 Long Borders for the sides 30 1/2 x 3 inches
Cut 2 Short Borders for the ends 16 1/2 x 3 inches



STEP 6 Assembling the Quilt

Add the borders to the center beginning with the long side strips of the first border. Press all seams away from the center of the quilt. The Reflections pattern provides four sizes, quilters who have completed larger Reflections quilts, may opt to make a larger Scrap Salad Quilt as shown below.

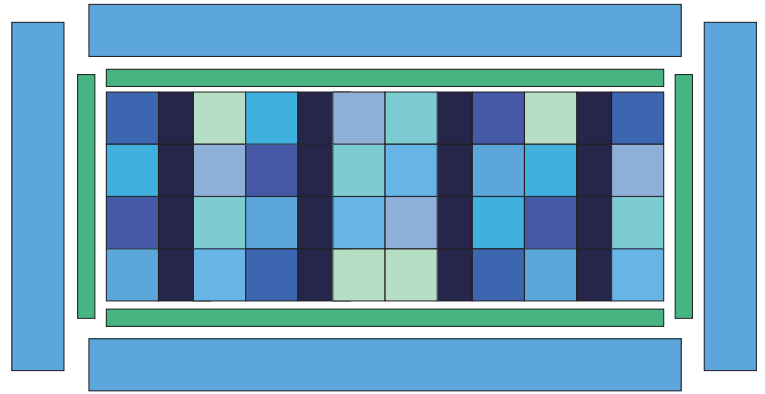
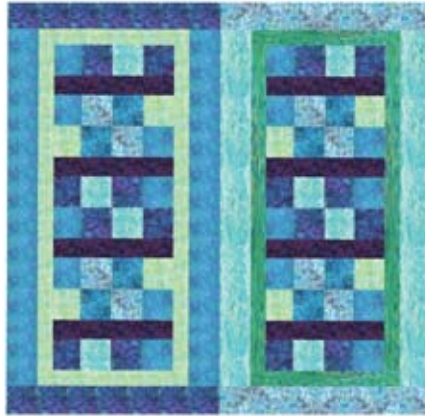


Table Runner
