

Circular Tumbleblock Table Topper

Materials, Yardage and Cutting

Cut From $\frac{1}{2}$ yard (**note if using two different fabrics will need $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of each*)

- Cut 12 tumble block using the GO! Cutter and Tumble Die# 55020 or the template provided on last page

Cut from 12" square

- Center circle

One 25" square

- Used as backing

Making the Outer Tumbleblock Ring

Sew the twelve tumble blocks together into a circle using a generous $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Press well so the ring lays flat.

Lay a circle template (a round plate works just fine) on the empty center of the ring. The template should extend onto the fabric a little bit. Trace around the template onto the fabric and then cut out along the traced line, so you have a completely round center.



Making the Center Circle

Measure the diameter of the circle in the center of the ring. (*mine measured 10 ½" but it is fine if it is a little bigger or smaller than this*)



Add 1 inch to the diameter measurement and cut your center circle to this size (e.g. if the diameter is 10 ½" cut your center circle fabric so that it has a diameter of 11 ½").



Putting it All Together

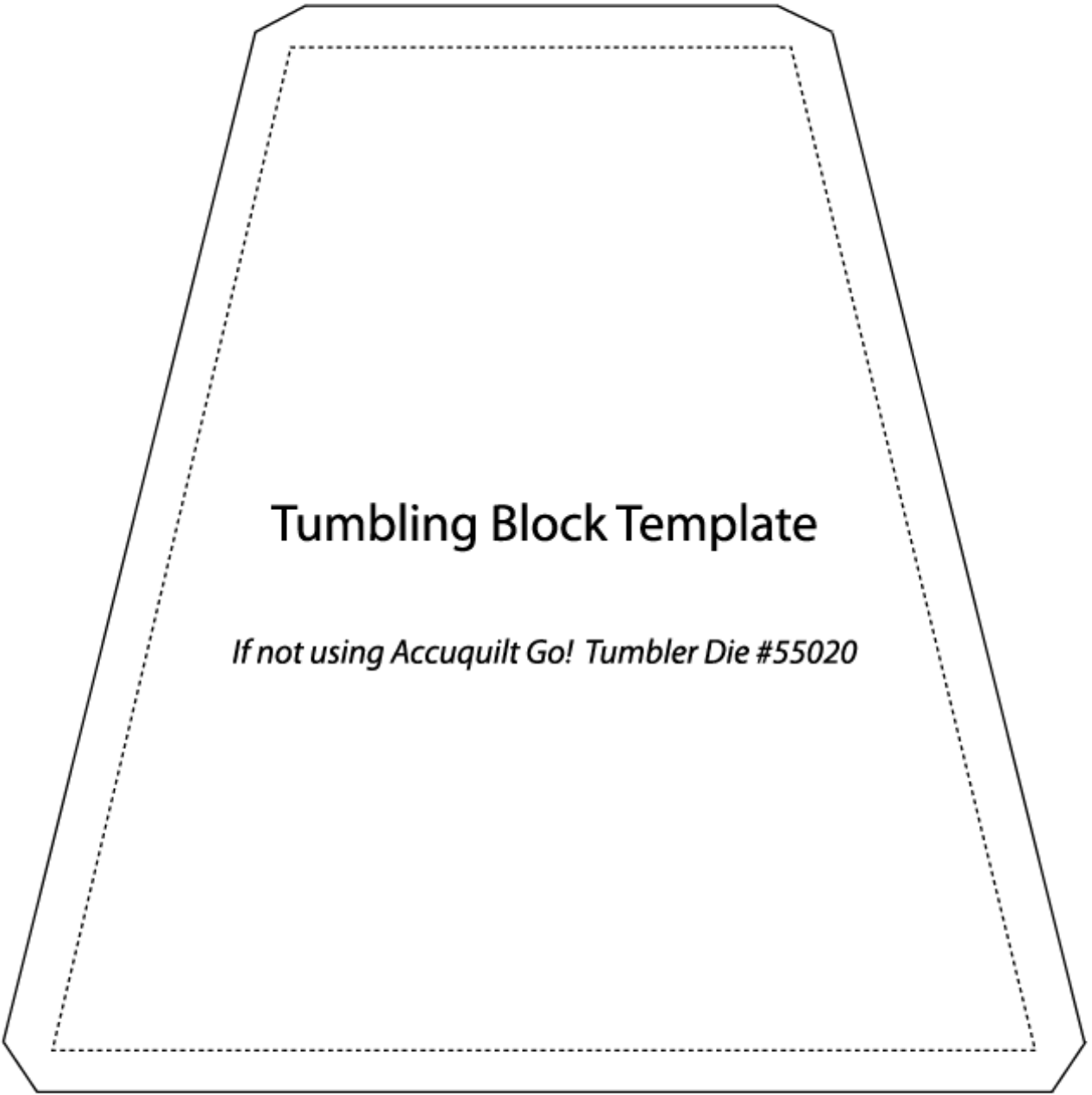
Lay the ring out with the wrong side of the fabric facing up. Place the center circle in the center of the ring with the wrong side of the fabric facing up. Pin the right sides together around the edge. When preparing to sew a curved edge it is helpful to use pin generously.



Baste along the pinned edge using a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Remove the pins and make sure that the Table topper lays flat, make any adjustments in the seam as needed. Sew around the seam with a regular $\frac{1}{4}$ " stitch. Press the table topper until it lays flat.

Berthing the Quilt

Layer a 25" square of batting, the 25" square of backing right side facing up and the pieced top wrong side facing up. Trim the batting and backing to match the pieced top. Sew the three layers together around the edge leaving a 4" opening. Turn the quilt inside out and press. Hand stitch the opening closed. Quilt as desired.
